



MEDICAL CARE

Teachers are trained in CPR and first aid in an attempt to provide on the spot care. However, if the child's injury or illness warrants medical care, the director will notify the parent to provide such for the child. If immediate emergency medical care is needed, 911 will be called and the child transported to the parent's hospital preference. The parents will be notified after 911 is called. If a child is transported by ambulance without the parent being reached the Medical Consent form located in the enrollment pack will be sent with the ambulance. This is the parents written consent that their child can be treated if they are unable to be reached. Parents are to make sure that their child's medical form has current health information regarding their child. All teachers are aware of any health conditions the children may have.
